

#### MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

## Harley-Davidson<sup>®</sup> FL Wrap-Around Backrest 2014-2015

Hardware: 1/4"-20 nuts x 3

1" zinc washer x 3

Rubber bumpers x 3

**Tools needed:**  $\frac{7}{16}$ " nut driver or wrench

#### **Installation of Mustang Backrest:**

Note: Mustang wrap-around backrest installs ONLY on King TourPaks and not on leather or chopped Paks.

- Open TourPak, locate and remove the three hex nuts holding stock wrap-around unit in place and remove.
- 2. Note locations of mounting holes in the lid. Mustang wraparound uses the two outermost holes and the upper center hole only.





- 3. Remove all supplied hardware from the studs on the back of the Mustang wrap-around except the rubber bumpers.
- 4. Align the studs with the holes in the TourPak, and push through.
- 5. Place one zinc washer and one hex nut on the studs inside of the lid. Tighten all three securely.
