

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Harley-Davidson® FXR 1982-1994, 1999-2000

One piece, Solo and Passenger Seats

Hardware: One-piece:

Stock hinge bracket or Mustang part 75080

Passenger seat: Solo seat:

Stock hinge bracket Optional: 5/16"-24 x 3/4"

slotted bolts (part 78027 - not

included)

Tools needed: Phillips screwdriver

1/2" open-end wrench or nutdriver

Removal of Stock Seat:

One-piece:

Remove rear fender screw and set aside. The stock rear fender screw will be used to attach your new Mustang seat. Slide seat back and up to remove.

Two-piece:

- 1. Unlatch solo and pivot up to expose hinge.
- 2. Disengage plastic retaining clip on hinge, slide solo back to clear the hinge and remove.
- 3. Remove rear fender screw and set aside. Loosen two front mounting bolts, and slide passenger seat back and up to remove.



Installation of Mustang Seat:

Solo and Passenger seat:

- 1. Transfer the hinge bracket from the stock seat to the Mustang solo.
- 2. Reconnect the hinge to the frame.
- 3. Install either stock bolts or washers **or** Mustang part 78027 slotted bolts into fender.
- 4. Engage slots in front of passenger seat either under the stock washers or into the slotted bolts. Tighten these bolts securely.
- 5. Align rear tab with the fender mount and secure with stock screw.



One-piece seat with OEM hinge:

- 1. Transfer the hinge bracket from the stock seat to the Mustang seat.
- 2. Align rear tab with the fender mount and secure with stock screw.

One-piece seat without using OEM hinge:

- 1. Bolt Mustang bracket part 75080 (not included) to the fuel tank's rear mounting holes.
- 2. Engage the front seat bracket into the bracket.
- 3. Align rear tab with the fender mount and secure with stock screw.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
