



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Triumph Rocket III Touring Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware:	Stock 6mm x 25mm Allen bolt Stock 8mm x 30mm Allen bolt x 2
Tools needed:	5mm Allen wrench 6mm Allen wrench <i>Optional:</i> Phillips screwdriver

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Remove the rear 6mm x 25mm Allen bolt from the fender with a 5mm Allen wrench, and the two side 8mm x 30mm Allen bolts from the frame with a 6mm Allen wrench, and set aside. These bolts will be used to mount your Mustang seat.



2. Lift the stock seat up and back to remove from motorcycle.

Note: The Mustang seat will install without use of the air intake assembly mounted to the stock seat. No performance issues should manifest as a result. If use of the air intake assembly is desired, remove the air intake from the stock seat by removing the seven Phillips screws and mount it to the seven 9/64" holes in the Mustang solo baseplate with these stock screws.

Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. If installing the passenger seat with the solo, slip the front bracket on the passenger seat into the rear bracket of the solo until they fit snugly together and install as a one-piece unit.
2. Slip the front bracket of the Mustang solo into the frame mount under the tank and set the seat down so the rubber bumpers contact the frame rails and fender.



3. Re-install the stock 8mm x 30mm Allen bolts through the solo seat brackets into the frame and tighten securely.
4. If installing the passenger seat with the solo, place the supplied shoulder washer onto the stock rear 6mm x 25mm Allen bolt with the widest part toward the head of the bolt, and install through the rear seat bracket into the fender. The smaller portion of the shoulder washer will sit inside the hole in the passenger seat's rear bracket. Tighten securely.
