



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Victory Vision 2008-2016 One-piece Seat

Tools needed: 4mm Allen wrench
Torque wrench

Note: Will not fit with the Vision Street Trunk Panel installed in place of the stock trunk.

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Open the glove compartment door and the fuel door. Tug on the three corners of the console trim panel to remove it from the pressure-fittings and lift straight up off the motorcycle.



2. Using a 4mm Allen wrench, remove the two bolts at the front of the seat.



3. Lift the front of the seat up and carefully slide the seat forward out of the frame mount. Unplug the heater power connector located under the rear of the seat, then lift the seat up and forward to remove from the motorcycle. **Note: Be extremely careful not to contact the fuel tank with the seat's front brackets.**



Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. Position the seat on the frame and connect the heater power connector at the rear of the seat.
2. Engage the seat's rear bracket with the rear fender mount. Pivot the seat down to the frame.
3. Install the two seat bolts at the front of the seat. Victory recommends torquing these bolts to 3 ft-lbs (36 in-lbs, 4 Nm).
4. Reinstall the console trim panel, and close the glove compartment and the fuel door.



5. To operate heaters, use the switches located under the left handrail. The driver (front) heat is controlled by the forward switch, and the passenger (rear) heat is controlled by the rearward switch. For each switch: front = high heat, center = off, back = low heat. The LED should glow a steady red when the heaters are activated on high or low.
